

Students and families at David Douglas Online Academy were surveyed in December 2021 about their perceptions of their school in terms of Engagement, Academic Challenge, Culture, Belonging & Peer Collaboration, and Relationships. In addition, students provided feedback about School Safety, Emotional and Mental Health, and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

We had a 36% response rate from students in grades 9-12. A 68% response rate from students in grades 7 to 8, and a 88% response rate from students in grades 3 to 5.

With the help of the nonprofit YouthTruth, we analyzed their responses to use for decision-making and improvements. Here are a few things we learned from the survey:



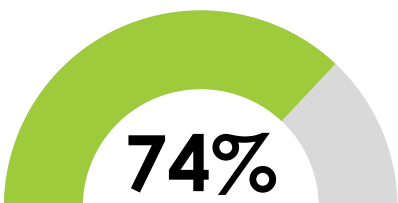
In A Student's Own Words

"My teachers give me courage to believe in myself to get good grades and try hard for good grades and they teach you stuff you are going to need in everyday life."

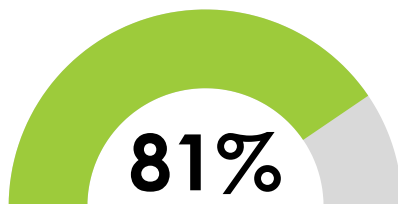

The percent of students in grades 3 to 5 who believe students in their class treat the teacher with respect.

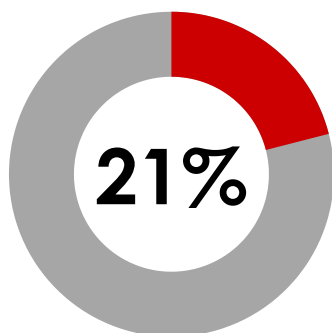


The percent of students in grades 7 and 8 who believe their teachers try to be fair.

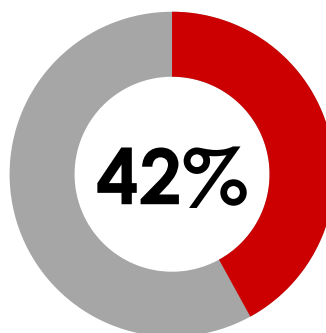


The percent of students in grades 9 through 12 who feel like they try their best in school.
